Aloha Roundup is a special event with workshops, not meetings. They require months of planning, preparation and money to present. Since this event is held at the McCoy Pavilion there are charges to use this facility. In addition to that charge our expenses include printing of schedules, flyers, post cards, dancers, food, postage, supplies, etc... A large event requires substantial amount of money. This roundup is self-supporting. No group funds were used to pay for this event. The ideal goal is to break even therefore; the registration fee is nominal compared to a long weekend's worth of entertainment.
